Arriving Movers Found the couple still sleeping after their big all night "moving away" party. Place was trashed, Nothing Pre-packed, Tons of Stuff and No Packing Materials. TIP: Be Realistic About Your Move —>Always Better To Over Estimate than to Under Estimate...
Extremely Common for Individuals Describing Their Move to "Lessen" or "Down Play" amount of Items and Actual Conditions onsite at locations of the relocation. "Under Estimating" usually leads to additional stress \& aggravation move day when a 3 bedroom home not completed in only $\mathbf{3}$ hours YOU unrealistically envisioned, planned \& budgeted for. Reality Check!
